LDR Decentralizes Course Certification

New procedures designed to decentralize the approval of road running courses were put into effect at the beginning of May by TAC's Long Distance Running Committee; the announcement was made by men's LDR chairman Bob Campbell of West Roxbury, Mass.

In the past, all certification requests had been channeled to LDR's national course certification chairman Ted Corbitt of New York; while the decentralization is not as yet nationwide, four other persons have been designated to review applications and authorize approvals in 19 states and the District of Columbia:

Course certification in all other parts of the country will continue to be reviewed by Corbitt (150 West 225th St., Apt. 8-H, Section 4, New York, N.Y. 10463).
